ANIMATION




Animation gives a sense of direction towards the goal.

DISCIPLES ON THE ROAD TO EMMAUS (Lk: 24)




SAMARITAN WOMAN


VI. ACCOMPANIMENT: A TIME OF RENEWAL AND GROWTH



1. The Role of Leadership


